

Outcomes	Gardening takes place in our college. Students actively participated.  Students and people knew the importance of tree plantation for saving our society.








Outcomes	Students and Villagers get knowledge about the disease and how to prevent it.














# Report on "De-plasticization" Programme in the Adopted Village

Brief Description of the Awareness Programme	De-plasticization was organized for a weekend and the purpose of the programme was to educate the adopted villagers about the harmful effect of plastic on agriculture and many other fields. NSS Volunteers, teachers and all staff arrived in the village at 11:30 a.m. and villagers joined us in a road march. We distributed the paper made bag (thole) among the villagers and informed them about various bad effect of plastic in routine life. People support the activities and share their personal opinion. After returning from village NSS volunteers and others students cleaned the plastic object of college ground and pick it up in a paper made dustbin.
