Outcomes	Cleaning programme promoted environmental consciousness among students. They learnt the importance of cleaning our surroundings and daily life for health and hygiene.





















Outcomes	Students knew the traffic rule and its importance for daily life. They understood the use of it and they promised to follow the rules properly.















