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Sri Ramkrishna Sarada Vidyamahapitha, Kamarpukur, Hooghly (here afterwards SRSVM) and Tehatta Sadananda Mahavidyalaya, Tehatta, Burdwan, 713122 (here afterwards TSM) wish to initiate collaboration in different disciplines through various programmes supported by the two institutions.

SRSVM and TSM recognize their strengths in education in the discipline of Science and Arts and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic as well as cultural cooperation.

Therefore, SRSVM and TSM agree to establish a programme for academic and cultural co-operation in areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

A. Objectives

The goal of this cooperation is to foster collaboration, provide opportunity for inter-institution exchange of experience, and to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best efforts and frequent interactions aiming at mutual benefits for both the institutions as per the Life & Teachings of Swami Vivekananda. SRSVM and TSM agree to explore the possibility of engaging in the following modes of collaboration:

- Provision of consultancy on the campus development of SRSVM and TSM by experts of both the institutions;
- Exchange of information on teaching, learning materials and other literature relevant to their academic programmes;
- Organization of seminars, conferences, workshops and short-term educational programmes jointly on topics of mutual interest, while extending invitations to each other's faculty to participate therein;
- Joint proposal in training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, while extending invitation to each other's faculty to participate therein;
- Organization of Cultural Competition jointly, exchange of students efficient in this sphere and also organization of Games' Competition and cooperation in this regard from both ends.

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B. Joint sponsored Development and Consulting

SRSVM and TSM agree to invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in development programmes of mutual interest. It is anticipated that the terms and conditions for such participation would be worked out by mutual agreement between the faculty member(s) and the institution extending such an invitation.

Further, SRSVM and TSM agree to jointly identify and pursue opportunities for formulation and submission of training programmes for possible funding by State or Central agencies, if needed.

It is foreseen that when a faculty member visits a partner institution on invitation, such a visit will be subject to the regulations of the individual partner institution.

C. Exchange of Faculty

SRSVM and TSM agree to explore ways of encouraging collaboration between faculties from the two institutions. Specifically, the two institutions would encourage members of their faculty to undertake short visits or take up fixed term assignments on visiting faculty.

D. Students Exchange

SRSVM and TSM agree to discuss the means for enabling the exchange of students between two institutions. Each exchanged student would be selected by mutual agreement and in accordance to the regulations of the partner institutions.

E. Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by Principal of the two institutions. It will remain valid for a period of five years. This MoU will be reviewed after three years; the terms of this MoU may be amended by mutual written agreement prior to the date of review. Any extension to this MoU will be formally approved in writing by the parties. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once terminated, neither SRSVM nor TSM will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, SRSVM and TSM will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

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Green Campus Initiative

Tehatta Sadananda Mahavidyalaya acknowledges the importance and need of environment conservation and sustainability in creating a healthier and more resilient campus community. The Green Campus Initiative aims to integrate sustainable practices into all aspects of college activities to foster a sense of responsibility regarding the conservation of environment among students, staff and other stakeholders of the college.

The aims and objectives of the Green Campus Initiative are as follows

- To raise an awareness among the college community about the need and importance of environmental conservation
- To reduce greenhouse gas emission and carbon footprint
- To conserve natural non-renewable resources and opt for renewable resources
- To promote energy efficiency
- To promote a plastic free and smoke free zone

Key initiatives taken by the college

➤ *To maintain a green campus*

The most important initiative undertaken by the college to promote sustainability and environmental consciousness is to maintain a huge green campus which encompasses several sections like evergreen trees, medicinal plants, seasonal flower garden and a pond. The college campus offers a natural sanctuary of biodiversity, tranquillity and natural beauty which forms an ideal backdrop for students, faculty and staff and provides them peace away from the din and bustle of the city.

The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of the college and other volunteers from students and staff play a pivotal role in maintaining the garden and watering the plants and special care is taken for the segments of medicinal plants and seasonal flowers. Regular pruning and pest control measures are undertaken to ensure a healthy environment.

➤ *Energy Efficiency*

To promote energy efficiency, Tehatta Sadananda Mahavidyalaya has adopted a comprehensive policy to reduce energy consumption and promote renewable energy sources. This includes installation of LED bulbs throughout the campus which has significantly reduced energy consumption and life span of the bulbs, thereby leading to long-term cost

savings and environmental benefits. The students and staff members are always encouraged to adopt simple and impactful habits like turning off all lights and fans before leaving the classrooms and switching off computers and other electrical appliances when not in use. Classrooms and office rooms are fitted with large windows to ensure abundant natural sunlight and cross ventilation which reduces the reliance on artificial sources of energy and electrical appliances thereby reducing energy consumption and associated carbon emissions.

➤ **Waste and Resource Management**

The college has adopted several measures to minimise the production of waste like paper, plastic, glass and other such materials. This is ensured by encouraging paperless office work and circulating e-notices to minimise environmental impact. Proper waste paper bins are also installed and students and staff are encouraged to use them for proper disposal.

The college takes appropriate measures to segregate wastes into bio-degradable and non-bio degradable categories. The bio- degradable wastes are then transferred to the compost pit and they are transformed into nutrient rich compost. It is then utilised in enriching the soil for gardening purposes thereby also reducing the use of chemical fertilizers. By adopting such vermicompost methods, we not only economically dispose the bio-degradable waste but also contribute to soil health and contribute to environmental conservation. The non-biodegradable wastes are collected by the local Panchayat as part of an agreement between the Panchayat and the college. Similarly the e-wastes are collected from all over the campus and are kept separately for proper disposal.

The college has encouraged the use of porcelain and terracotta cutlery to minimise the use of single use plastic products. The college also conducts awareness programmes with the aim of reducing plastic waste generation and promote a culture of sustainability among students and staff.

Students and staff members are also encouraged to use eco-friendly modes of transportation to reduce carbon emissions which includes using electric scootys, Totos (e-rickshaws), bicycles and walking. This helps in reducing air pollution and greenhouse emissions associated with conventional modes of transportation.

➤ **Water Management and Ground water Recharge**

To ensure the uninterrupted supply of clean water to sustain life, water conservation is essential. It involves the practice of using water efficiently to reduce unnecessary water usage. Understanding the imperative importance of water and the need to conserve it, Tehatta Sadananda Mahavidyalaya has adopted a multi-faceted approach towards water conservation. The initiative is practically implemented in the following two ways-

- By rainwater harvesting
- By ground water recharge

The college has adopted methods to collect rain water and re-direct it to reservoirs to store them for different purposes like watering the campus potted plants and cleaning the campus.

A soak pit is also created to recharge ground water. Through these initiatives, the college aims to reduce unnecessary water wastage, enhance water availability, reduce dependency on conventional sources of water and remain equipped for unforeseen situations of water crisis.

➤ *Cleanliness Drives*

The college actively promotes cleanliness both within and without the campus. The NSS unit organises several awareness programs and campaigns from time to time to make people aware of the importance of cleanliness and personal hygiene. The volunteers regularly undertake cleanliness drives both within the campus and in the neighbourhood of Tehatta village to foster a sense of responsibility among the students, staff and the community at large towards maintaining cleanliness thereby contributing towards a sustainable and better environment.

➤ *Maintaining Safety Standards*

The college ensures a regular inspection and monitoring of all electrical and plumbing lines to prevent any type of mishap and unwanted incidents. These preventive measures are aimed to minimise the risk of accidents and damage by ensuring the proper functioning and safety of the electrical and plumbing systems throughout the campus.
