#### Brief Description of the Awareness Programme

Covid Cell organized an awareness campaign to prevent the transmission of the covid-19 among students and villagers' collaboration with NSS Unit-1 on 16.11.21 at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday. All the students, NSS Volunteers, and teaching staff joined the programme on that day. Dr. Nilanjan De, Chief Patron joined the programme and discussed the various impact o covid -19 on society. The event was conducted very seriously by Covid Cell members.

Dr. Ruchira Chanda, Assist. Prof. & HOD Bengali Department, explained the symptoms, general principals, basic infection control measures in detail. She gave detailed information about patients with Covid-19 what precautions they could take to prevent spreading it to others: isolation, masking, and avoiding contact with people who are at high risk of getting very sick. Isolation is used to separate people with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 from those without COVID-19.

#### **Outcomes**

Students knew about the symptoms, isolation process and various sides of Covid-19 and its impact on mass people in daily life. They also gathered knowledge about what precautions should be taken in this situation.
