The Theme

The word Literature has come from Latin word *literatura* which means all types of written account. The concept has changed meaning over time to include texts that had been originally nonwritten or verbal art forms like spoken or sung items. Development in Print technology has allowed an ever growing distribution and proliferation of written works, culminating in electronic literature.

But the basic question still remains to be answered : What is literature? Why do we read literature? Conventionally it has been said that written works, especially those considered of superior or lasting artistic merit may be called literature. But superior in which sense? What is meant exactly by 'lasting artistic merit'? What are its characteristics? These need to be specifically determined and theoritized.

Then in Sanskrit literary theory it has been categorically specified that reading of literature or visualization of literary items like drama, offer us pleasure, causes "rasa nispati". But what is 'rasa'? How dan its true effect be properly tasted or achieved? Questions like these lead us to the philosophy or soul of literature, to its meaning and additional meanings which like the ever extending circles in a pond move wider whenever a stone is dropped in it.

Students, scholars, critics, philosophers and literary artists, sitting together, may fix and resolve guidelines how to answer these questions, what to read in literature and why and how. The present seminar takes its origin from such an intension to address these basic important matters and to erase the frowns, doubts, riddles and misconceptions about literature, about its nature, theory, practice and application.

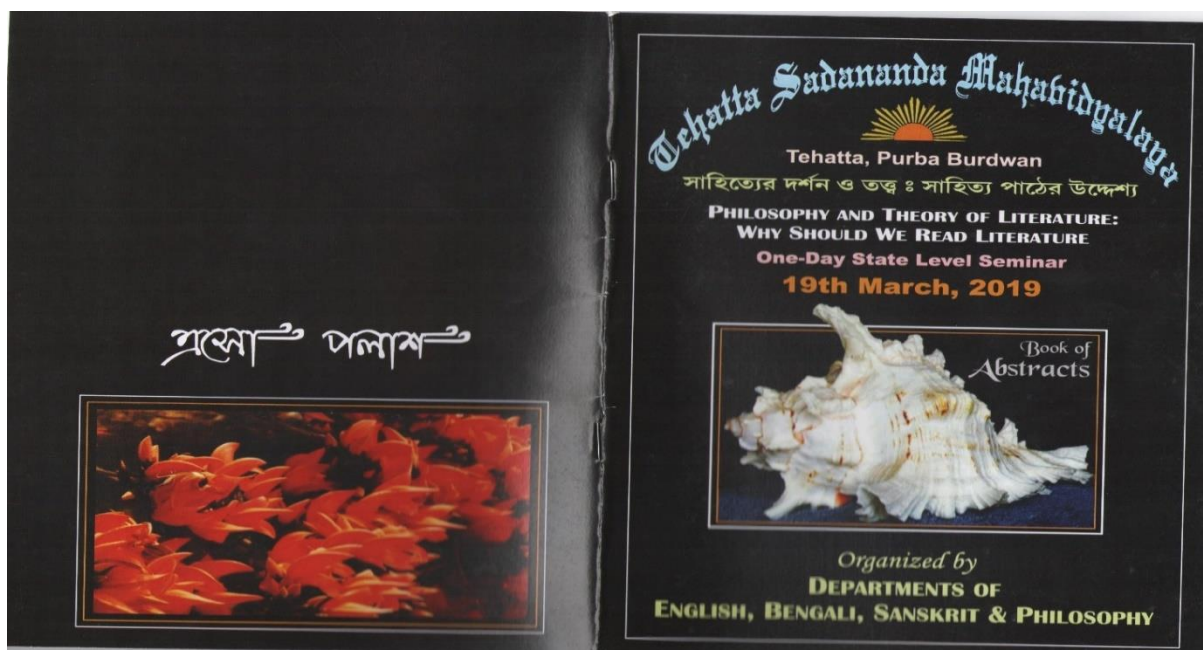
How to Reach

Aims and objective	The aim of the seminar was to address and resolve questions related to literature, such as what to read, why to read, and how to read. The seminar originated from the intention



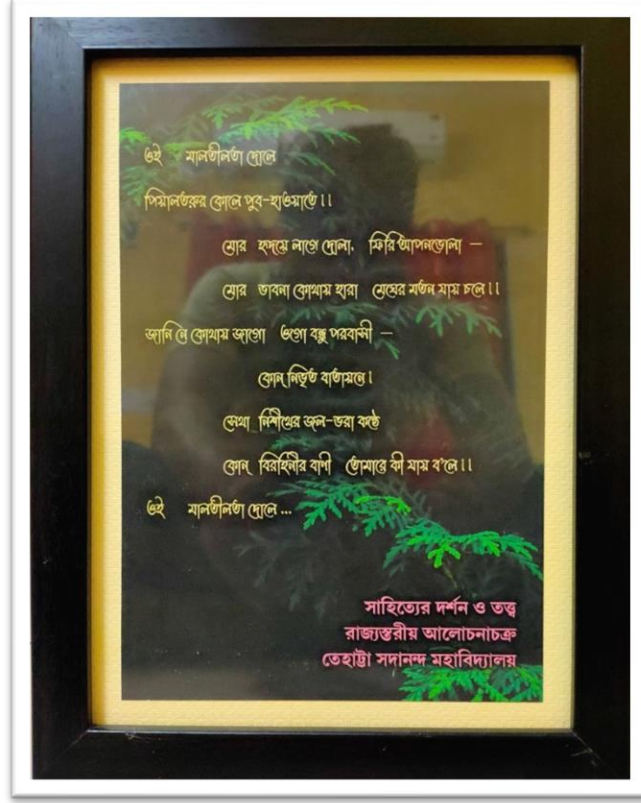

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	to clarify common misconceptions about literature, including its nature, theory, practice, and application.
<p>A brief Description of the Seminar</p>	<p>Tehatta Sadananda Mahavidyalaya organized a seminar on "Philosophy and Theory of Literature: Why Should We Read Literature" on Tuesday, March 19th, 2019. The seminar was inaugurated by our Teacher-In-Charge, Dr. Pritam Das, an Assistant Professor in Education, at 10:30 a.m. He warmly welcomed all the students, honourable speakers, paper presenters, and participants who came to our college in the remote area. Our President, Shri Pranab Roy, a social worker, also addressed the session and greeted everyone.</p> <p>After the inauguration session, the first technical session started at 11:30 a.m. In the first technical session, our invited resource person, Dr. Sujit Kr. Chowdhary, Inspector of College, Burdwan University, deeply discussed why we should read literature and its importance in our daily lives. His lecture engaged the students and connected their minds to another world. Several renowned professors, poets, scholars, and literary artists came to the seminar from Kolkata, Bardhaman, and Kalyani University. <p>Outcomes</p>	<p>The students gained new knowledge from the lecture which changed their perspective on literature reading. They actively participated in a question-answer session to learn more about their areas of interest. The seminar highlighted the importance of constructing basic concepts of literature, and the day was a great success. It was a major achievement for Tehatta College as a book of abstracts was published on that day.</p>
