<b>A brief Description of the Seminar</b>	<p>The seminar was inaugurated at 11:00 a.m. by our T.I.C, Dr. Banibrata Goswami. The program coordinator, Ruchira Chanda, Assistant Professor in the Department of Bengali, conducted the entire program very sincerely. 

<b>Aims and objective</b>	<p>The purpose of the seminar was to introduce students to new concepts of knowledge. The seminar emphasized and explained how to develop skills that can turn humans into valuable resources. It also motivated students to focus on their educational skill development for a brighter future.</p>
<b>A brief Description of Field Trip</b>	<p>The Geography Department organized a departmental seminar on "The Concept of Human Resources" on July 22, 2019, starting at 11:00 a.m. onwards. The seminar was inaugurated by T.I.C Dr. Banibrata Goswami. Dr. Pritam Das, IQAC Coordinator joined with him. The programme was started on time and conducted sincerely by Ms. Alokanda Ghosh, Assistant Professor of Geography. All staff and students participated in the seminar.</p> <p>The keynote speaker, <b>Professor (Dr.) Anuradha Guha Thakurata</b> from the Geography Department at Shyamshundar College, delivered a lecture on Human Resources. She provided a brief description of the topic with a PPT presentation, explaining the matrices, stats, and numbers related to human resources and their purpose. She highlighted that human resource productivity in our overpopulated world is not a bad thing, but the proper use of human resources is profitable for the nation. The lecture was fruitful, and students learned something new that day. After the lecture session, certificates were distributed to the students.</p>



As a promoter of girls' education, he established around 35 schools. He did not believe in God and opposed Hindu orthodoxy. Yet, he did a lot for people.

Vidyasagar was a great writer and also known as the father of modern Bengali language. He had written many books and thus enriched the Bengali education system to a great extent. Many Bengali alphabets were revised by him. He also wrote a book on grammar rules of Sanskrit that is used till date. His contribution to the translation of several Sanskrit books, including Kalidas's *Shankuntala*, has helped Bengali literature, especially Bengali Prose to achieve a strong base for further development in subsequent time.

A proponent of "do your work yourself", Vidyasagar is considered a legend ahead of his times—someone who could challenge the staunch Hindu patriarchy to bring in modern reforms. He never feared to make experiments and never hesitated to fight with orthodoxy. Disappointed about the strict adherence to age old blind habits by the surrounding people, and upset about their mental resistance to light and logic, Vidyasagar spent the last 18 years of his life living among Santhal tribals in present day Jharkhand. But still he started there, what is possibly India's first school for Karamatar, also stands outstanding. All these offer samples of the iron determination and undaunted spirit of a steadfast man who always cried within for his fellow suffering multitude and never retreated to serve others, teach others, even by making himself a coolie.

India needs today such dedicated, humble and determined personalities who can bring all sorts of required reforms by working solely for the betterment of the society than their own individual interest.

#### The Theme :

Great people are born to make an impact on society. Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar, the grammarist, polymath, scholar, educationist, reformer and doyen of the Bengal Renaissance has been a ready reference for millions of Bengalis till date, not only to encourage their children to study but also to strive for excellence in the face of adversity. Every child is told the story of how Vidyasagar, born into a poor family, studied by street light because there was no gas lamp at home. Vidyasagar's *Barna Parichay* (an introduction to the Bengali alphabet) is still the first book a Bengali child is handed more than 160 years after it was written. His contribution towards education and changing the status of women in India was remarkable. Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar strongly protested against polygamy, child-marriage and favored widow remarriage and women's education in India. Because of his contribution towards such issues, the Widow Remarriage Act was passed in 1856 making the marriage of widows legal. Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar worked towards providing education to women. He opened and ran many schools for girls at his own expense. He was also known as "Dayar Sagar" or "Karunar Sagar" (literally, "ocean of kindness") because of his charitable nature and generosity.

Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar was born in an orthodox family on 26th September 1820. Since childhood he was keen to get more and more knowledge. Because of his vast knowledge on different subjects, the title Vidyasagar was given to him when with an outstanding academic performance, he graduated from Sanskrit College. Vidyasagar means an ocean of learning ("vidya" – learning, "sagar" – ocean). A Sanskrit scholar, Vidyasagar also completed a law degree conducted by the Hindu Law Committee, before joining Fort William College as the head of the Sanskrit department in 1841. Subsequently, in 1846, he joined the Sanskrit College (his alma mater) as principal, and went against convention to admit students from lower castes to study Sanskrit.

Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar, along with many other active reformers opened schools for girls. This was because, for him, educational reform was much important than any other reform. He believed that the status of women and all kinds of injustice and inequalities that they face could be changed only through education. Vidyasagar's contribution to elementary through tertiary education in the state is unparalleled. He also took on conservative power centres of the Hindu society to force through reforms that would allow widow remarriage, women's education and the rights of lower caste Hindus to study Sanskrit. Considered a social reformer on a par with Raja Ram Mohan Roy, Vidyasagar also challenged the widespread practice of child marriage.

Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar strove endlessly to provide equal education to all men and women irrespective of their caste, religion and gender. He worked hard to uplift the status of women in India especially in his native Bengal. He was a social reformer and wanted to change the orthodox Hindu society from within. Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar introduced the practice of widow remarriage and worked against polygamy.

Vidyasagar wrote two volumes on the mistreatment of widows, which set the tone for major social reform in the state. He was an educationist, a reformer and a pundit of grammar.

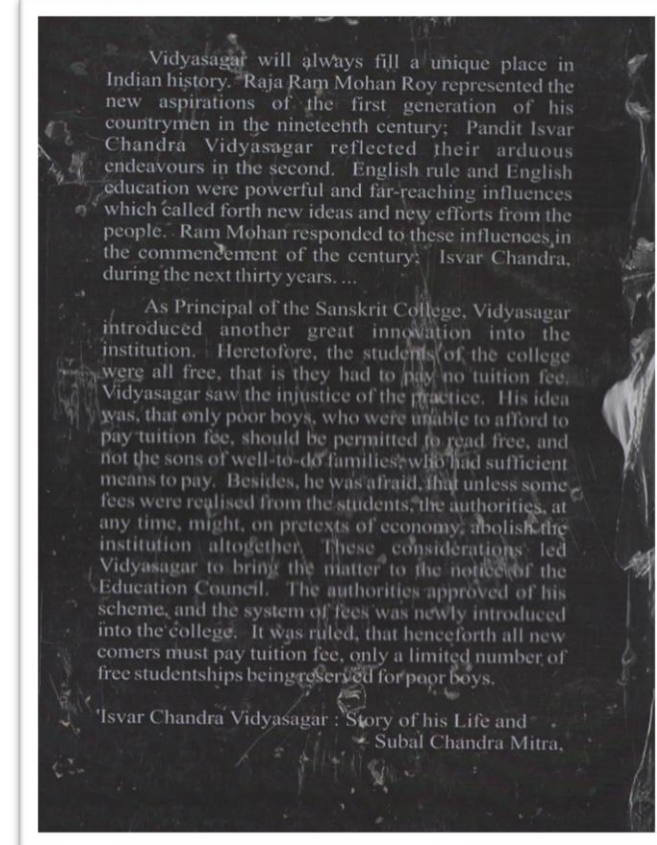
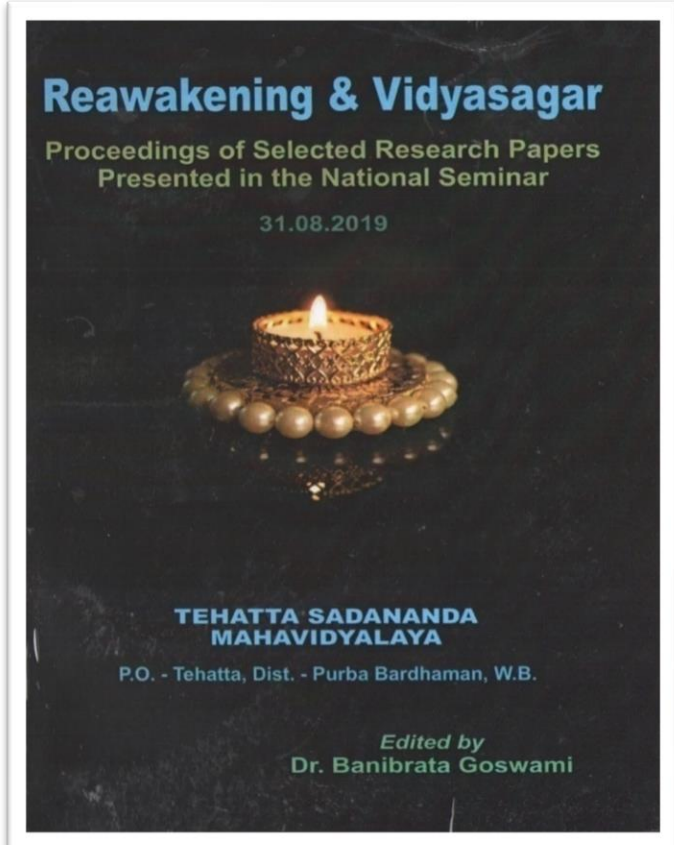
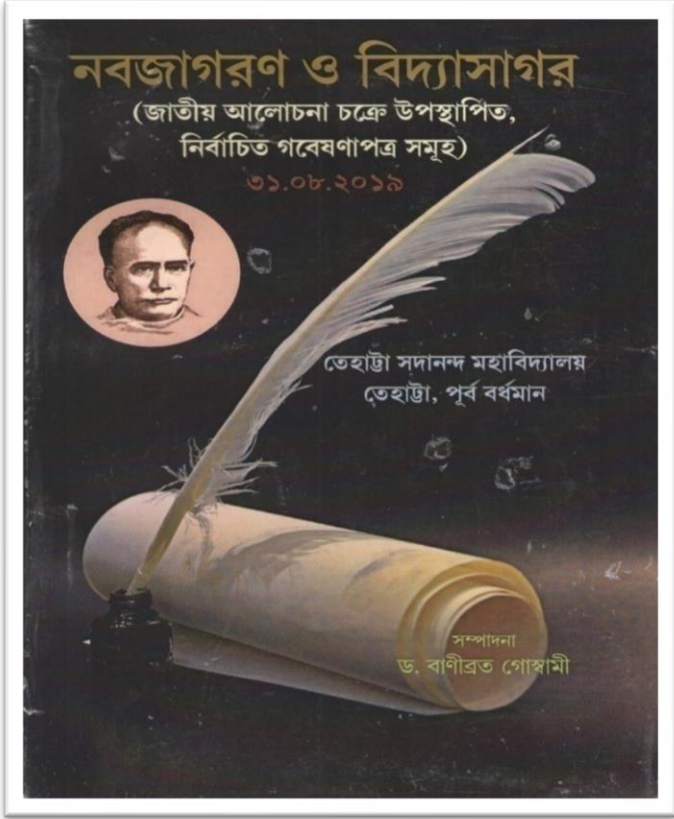
**Outcomes**

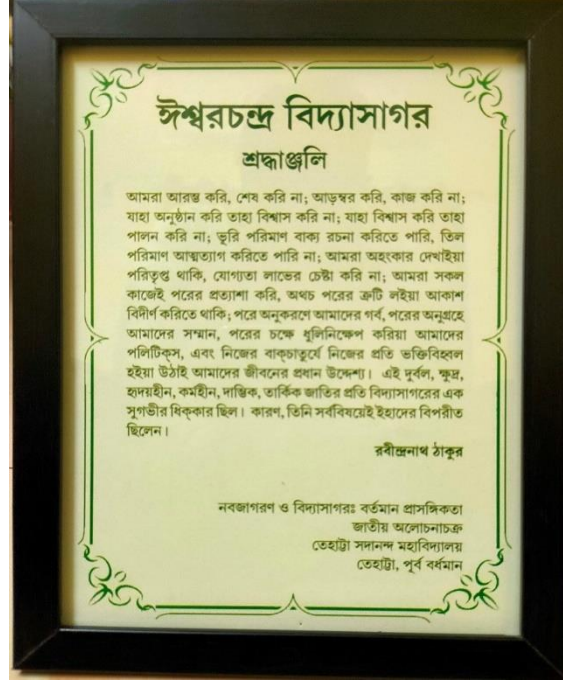





**The Theme :**

Unity implies one-ness or a sense of wholeness, meaning integration wherein hitherto divisive people and culture are synthesized into a united whole, along with higher levels of cooperation, mutual understanding, shared values, common identity and above all national consciousness. It holds tightly together the various relationships of ethnic groups or institutions in a dovetailed manner through the bonds of contrived structures, norms and values. It has also been described as a social psychological condition. However, unity does not mean uniformity which implies similarity. Unity may be born out of similarity.

The reverse of the term 'unity' is 'diversity' denoting collective differences so as to find out dissimilarities among groups of people: biological, religious linguistic etc. Ethnic diversity is perceived on the basis of biological

diversity. Religious diversity is visualized on the basis of religion or faith. Linguistic diversity is marked on the basis of languages spoken by a group of people. Thus all these differences presuppose collective differences or prevalence of variety of groups and cultures.

India, a vast peninsular sub-continent, also known as 'Bharat Varsha', has a total land area of about 33 million sq.kms. and population exceeding 800 millions. The seventh largest and the second most populous nation of the world (with 2.4 percent of world's land area and 15.0 percent of the population of the world) India, possesses varieties of social, economic, geographical and ecological conditions.

Its hoary past stretching over five thousand years of human civilization provides the most distinctive features in the coexistence of unity in diversity. "This overworked cliché has become a part of India's self-identity. In the past, foreign travellers-among others Megasthenes (C.315 B.C.), like Fa-Hsien (A.D.405-11), Huan Tsang (A.D. 630-44), Alberuni (A.D. 1030) Marco polo (A.D. 1288-93) and Ibn Batuta (A.D. 1325-51) observed and recorded this" (1) The distinctive feature of India in its unity and diversity is also reflected in the social ethos. The causative factors leading to the emergence of this unique feature of the Indian polity are not far to seek. This trend of unity in diversity in India can be examined by identifying on the one hand, the factors that have led to regional differentiation and diversities and the factors operating as bonds of unity.

The sources of diversity in India may be traced through a variety of ways, the most obvious being the ethnic origins, religions, castes, tribes, languages, social customs, cultural and sub-cultural beliefs, political philosophies and ideologies, geographical variations etc.
