

In compliance with the legal provisions the Committee aspires to ensure women's rights to workplace equality, free from sexual harassment through compliance with the three elements of Prohibition, Prevention and Redress. Any form of unwanted behavior including but not limited to a) Physical contact and advances b) Solicitation of any form of sexual favors c) Making sexually suggestive remarks d) Displaying pornographic material and e) Any other unwelcome gesture of sexual nature (both verbal and non-verbal) constitute sexual harassment in the workplace. Such actions violate the fundamental rights of women to equality under Articles 14 and 15 and the right to life and live with dignity under Article 21 of the constitution. Moreover such actions and behaviors contravene with their right to engage in any profession within a gender safe environment free from any kind of sexual harassments. The college maintains a 'Zero Tolerance Policy' towards sexual harassment of any kind. To address such instances of sexual harassment effectively, a committee comprising of members of various designations has been formed. Victims of sexual harassment are encouraged to contact any member of this committee over phone, or in writing communicating their concerns to the Principal. The passage of time between the occurrence and the complaint will not be considered an issue for redressal. Upon receipt of a complaint, a prompt and confidential meeting will be convened by the committee within 48 hours where the victim/s may be requested to present themselves physically before the committee members to provide a statement. Subsequently, it will be redressed within a period of 10 days after its lodging, ensuring a swift resolution and appropriate justice. Anti Ragging Policy

According to UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 Ragging is a criminal offense and UGC has framed regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (g) of sub-section (1) of section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the UGC notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009". These regulations are mandatory for all universities/ institutions.

This policy has been formulated in consonance with UGC Rules regulations and judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on Anti Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions / Universities.

What constitutes Ragging

Ragging constitutes one or more to a fresher or any other student of any of the following acts:

- Any disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written or by an act, has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness a fresher or a junior student.
- Indulging in a rowdy or undisciplined activity that causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or junior student.
- Asking the students to do any act or perform something that generating a sense of shame or embarrassment which can lead to adverse effects such as depression, anxiety, and sometimes even suicide.
